Representation includes members from Canadian Cystic Fibrosis Foundation (CCFF) chapters in BC, CCFF regional directors, an Adult CF Liaison, a District 5 Kin Liaison and advisors from BC CF clinics. The Association, whose programs are partially supported by a Government of BC Direct Access Grant, seeks to improve the quality of life for persons with cystic fibrosis by:

- supporting CF clinics and outreach clinics
- raising public awareness of CF
- encouraging and developing CF volunteers
